

# **CLUB WORLD CUP 2022**

Modrice, Czechia June 25-26, 2022

## **Playing system**

Participants: teams from Czechia, Slovakia, Romania, France, Poland, Hungary, Italy, Spain and Cyprus

Matches in two groups on 2 indoor courts. One group has four (4) teams, the other five (5) teams; group composition will be drawn in the evening during technical meeting in the sport hall.

1<sup>st</sup> seeding of teams (two in group A, two in group B): Czechia, Slovakia, Romania, France

2<sup>nd</sup> seeding of teams (one in group A, one in group B): Poland, Hungary

3<sup>rd</sup> seeding of teams (one in group A, one in group B): Italy, Spain

Drawing: Cyprus in group A or B

### **Main tournament – Saturday, June 25,2022**

Teams in the group will play against each other in three (3) games for every team in this order: single, double, triple. **For every set won, the team receives one point.**

Criteria for advancing to semifinals

First two teams in both groups with most set points from both groups advance to the semifinals.

If two (2) or more participants win the same number of set points, the following criteria are in force:

- a) More set points from the matches played between themselves
- b) Higher difference ball points from the matches between themselves
- c) Same criteria in the same order a), b) from all matches in the group
- d) Drawing lots if all the criteria are the same.

The third teams play immediately after groups for the 5<sup>th</sup> place, the fourth teams play for the 7<sup>th</sup> place, the fifth team in one group is the ninth. These two matches are played in the same way as in semifinals, i.e. S1-D1-T and possibly D2 and S2

### **Final stage – Sunday, June 26,2022**

Two semifinal matches (A1-B2, B1-A2) on one central court, then the match for the 3<sup>rd</sup> place and the final match will be played.

Each match consists of max. five (5) games for every team in this order: 1<sup>st</sup> single, 1<sup>st</sup> double, triple, 2<sup>nd</sup> double, 2<sup>nd</sup> single. For every game won, the team receives one point. The first team to win three (3) game points is the winner.

1<sup>st</sup> single and 2<sup>nd</sup> single must be different players, 1<sup>st</sup> double and 2<sup>nd</sup> double must be composed of different players.
